

# GRADE RUAN ANNUAL PARISH MEETING

12 April 2021

Minutes of the Grade Ruan Annual Parish Meeting held online on the above date, 18:30.

<p><b>Persons Present/Apologies</b> Present: Cllr Preston (Chair), L Dunkley (Clerk), Cllr Rule CC, 7 parishioners.</p> <p>Cllr Preston expressed condolences on behalf of the community for the Duke of Edinburgh, who died on 9<sup>th</sup> April 2021.</p>
<p><b>Annual Parish Meeting: Minutes 8 April 2019.</b> <b>RESOLVED</b> that the Minutes of the Annual Parish Meeting of Grade Ruan held on the above date having been previously circulated, be taken as read, approved and signed.</p> <p>Proposed. Seconded. Carried by majority.</p>
<p><b>Report from the Chair of the Parish Council</b> Cllr Preston highlighted the difficulties with conducting Council business during the COVID pandemic. It was noted that 27 planning applications were considered in the preceding 12 months. Significant progress has been made regarding: Recreation Ground lease; Public consultation on fishing cellars purchase; common land issues; cycle hoops project, Martha's Acre access. Of particular note was the work done by the Council to survey and prepare to purchase the Winch House, and to join in the creation of the Cadgwith Fishing Cove Trust.</p>

<p><b>Report from Grade Ruan Recreation Ground Committee</b> Per <a href="#">written report</a> circulated. Clarification on the ownership of the Pavilion was requested. It was suggested that a solicitor should be engaged by the Committee.</p>
<p><b>Report from Tree Wardens</b> An update was given on the work being undertaken in the past twelve months. Red flowering hawthorns are among the new trees planted.</p>
