

GRADE RUAN ANNUAL PARISH MEETING

11 May 2022

Minutes of the Grade Ruan Annual Parish Meeting held on Wednesday 11 May at the Sunday School Room of Ruan Minor Methodist Chapel, 6:30pm.

<p>Persons Present/Apologies Present: Cllr Preston (Chair), L Dunkley (Clerk), 11 members of the public.</p>
<p>Annual Parish Meeting: Minutes 12 April 2021. RESOLVED that the Minutes of the Annual Parish Meeting of Grade Ruan held on the above date having been previously circulated, be taken as read, approved and signed. Proposed. Seconded. Carried by majority.</p>
<p>Report from the Chair of the Parish Council Cllr Preston gave a report on the preceding 12 months including: the return of face to face meetings; 36 planning applications consulted on and responded to; the joint peninsula-wide Hospital Cross planning application response coordinated by this Council; the purchase of the Winch House; Neighbourhood Plan discussions; ongoing dialogue with stakeholders; establishment of social media presence for the Council.</p>
<p>Report from the Cadgwith Fishing Cove Trust Trust N Green presented information contained within a written report.</p>
<p>Report from the Community Land Trust P Collins gave a report on the preceding 12 months including: the official opening of new local needs housing, which received significant press attention; potential funds coming in for Parish projects from a development at Kennack Sands.</p>
<p>Report from Village Hall A Agguter gave a report on the preceding 12 months including: fire prevention and health and safety matters being addressed; the quiz and the Thursday market have returned; there is a good management team in place.</p>
<p>Report from Grade Ruan Recreation Ground Committee M Fleetwood gave a report on the preceding 12 months including: healthy finances; popularity of Fridays in the summer in particular; successful events such as firework night; a donation was made of £1,000 to the Churches Trust; potential refurbishment of the tennis courts and additional patio area; a part time bar manager and part time bookkeeper have been employed.</p>
<p>Report from Tree Wardens Cllr Preston gave a report on the preceding 12 months including: continued advise given on planting; £200 from the Council has been spent on Grey Alder, Wild Cherry and Aspen which replicate the growth habit of Cornish Elm – a hedging tree; potential project forthcoming at the footpath between Kuggar-Gwendreath.</p>
<p>Report from Grade Ruan Community Trust P Collins gave a report on the preceding 12 months including: a collapsed wall has been rebuilt at Cadgwith car park; Judith Heather is the new secretary; no grant requests have been received recently so the Trust will advertise their fund.</p>
<p>Public Participation. C Hunt raised a matter regarding Ruan Major Church, and asked the Council to consider if it wished to take a position on ownership to preserve. The Council will consider at it's meeting in June. The meeting closed at 18:55.</p>
